Youth Forum (18th July)

The Bazar (18th July)

The Bazar is organized to provide extra funding for a local charity. The Hungarian organisation has chosen Pro Rekreatioe Közhasznú, which runs an integrated health, rehabilitation and educational centre for the early development of children from 0 to 6 years old.

For the Bazar on Friday 18 July, which starts at 8.00 Pm, each delegation brings along the things they want to sell to the Arena. Separate arrangements will be made with Chile and Flanders, because their accommodation is some distance from the campus.. There will be a table for each country, that will be clearly marked. **A few things require special attention:**

- After things have been handed in at the table of your country (7.50 pm at the latest) , the youngster go back through the tunnel to wait for the start; two people stay with the table to keep an eye on things.
- Everybody starts selling at the same time, so wait for the announcement.
- Prices can be in Hungarian Forint (HUF) or Euros; the exchange rate is 400 HUF = € 1,00. CIRPP will give each country a list of amounts in both currencies.
- Countries have to provide their own change (small banknotes or Euro coins)
- It is strictly forbidden to sell alcoholic drinks to the participants; volunteers of the local organisation and members of CIRPP will be walking around to keep an eye on this.
- At the end each country hands in their amount to Gert van Damme (Flanders) or Jane Kappers (The Netherlands). They will be at a table near the entrance to the tunnel.

At the closing ceremony on Saturday a cheque will be presented to the charity. We will also inform all countries of the amount they have collected with an email to the national delegates.

Ludovika dormitory
